We retain the results and project data for **5 years** from the date of the completed analysis. This allows us to reprocess or reference the data upon your request, ensuring continuity in service.

6. Data Security and Pseudonymization

We take data protection seriously. All chemical samples and the corresponding results are **pseudonymized**. This means the data is stored in a way that cannot be directly linked to a company or an individual without additional information, which is kept separately and securely.

7. Data Sharing

We do not share your personal data with any third parties unless it is necessary to fulfill the analytical services or if we are legally required to do so. We do not sell or market personal data to any third parties.

8. Your Rights

Under the GDPR, you have the following rights regarding your personal data:

- **Erasure:** You can request deletion of your personal data, subject to certain conditions.
